In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Bharathiya College of Education, Ammapalayam Post, Arur Taluk, Salem District - 636141, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Secondary(B.Ed) Course of One year from the academic session 2003-04 with an annual intake of 100 students.

3. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the report received from the visiting team, the Committee has issued the following:
- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the government building is reconstructed within a period of 2 years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has secured an Endowment fund of Rs. 5,000 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 4.2 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven teachers for the said course.
4. Since the institution, in pursuance of the process stated under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Bharathiya College of Education, Ammapalayam Post, Arur Taluk, Salem District - 636141, Tamilnadu to offer Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2003-04 with an annual intake of 100 students, subject to fulfillment of the following:
- a. The institution will ensure that Eighty(80) teachers faculty members duly approved by the affiliating university are in position for an intake of 100 students. The Southern Regional Committee will be kept in copy by the institution about the date of the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the course.
 - b. The institution shall start its own practice within three years from the date of recognition for when the course is started on temporary premises.



- c. The institution shall, within one month of the expiry of recognition order, submit the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION

- The initial enrolment with the University for developmental activities. U. S fee be retained and the interest of that amount every year will go to the University for developmental activities.
- No enrolment fee will be collected for further affiliation of courses.
- The teachers appointed should not exceed the age of superannuation which may be prescribed by the University / State Government from time to time.
- Approval of specialisation should be obtained from the University before the commencement of the course.

- Necessary Hostel accommodation, staff quarters, playground etc to be provided.
- Arrangements should be made for the conduct of University examinations.
- The courses should be conducted in accordance with the regulations and syllabi approved by the University from time to time.
- No donations should be obtained from students seeking admission to any course of study in the college.
- Excess admissions should never be made to any course over and above the sanctioned strength of the respective course(s).
- A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical Officer with the prescribed qualification should be appointed.
- The College shall implement each and every one of the recommendations of the inspection commission.
- Such other conditions as may be prescribed from time to time by the University should also be complied with.
